

MEAL CARDS POLICY FOR 2011-2012
Revised 9/30/2011

Meal Cards are part of the student dress code. They are not required to be on their necks unless they need to use them in the cafeteria. At other times of the day, they can be kept in a backpack, locker or cubby.

Pink emergency Card:

To be used only during **lunch time**. It is the responsibility of the child to ask for his pink-emergency card during their advisory time. Students without a lanyard or their pink card will be given cereal!!

Yellow Breakfast Card:

To be used only during **breakfast time**.

Meal card is part of the uniform this year; if they don't have their cards with them, please remind them that if the issue persists, they will be reported to the dean. The NTA will write down each student's name. If the student needs their **Yellow Breakfast Card** more than once, their name should be given to Tr. Neyza, who will follow up with the student.

Green Card:

Only for **1st and 2nd graders** during **lunch time** as an emergency card; if you see that the same kid is coming over to use it, please **report** his/her name so I can make a replacement card for him/her. The NTA or Dean will keep track of the students who need to use the **Green Card**. If a student needs to use the card repeatedly, the NTA or Dean will give their name to Tr. Neyza who will follow up with the student.

Replacement Cards:

Front office will **not** be giving out slips to purchase a lunch. No other teacher will be allowed to sign for a student lunch...only Tr. Neyza or Tr. Maureen will be able to sign for a student lunch.

Children should come to the front desk to request a replacement card. The student should then come back the following day, before their lunch, to pick up the card at the front desk. They will **not** be given a slip to purchase a meal the day they make the request.

During fire drills children who are in the cafeteria need to leave their food on the table, let's make sure to tell them that they don't have to throw it away! Children will not be given a 2nd lunch if they do!

Breakfast is served from 7:45am to 8:20 am. Students who arrive to school at or after 8:20 am will be given a bagged breakfast. All students **must** get breakfast as soon as they arrive to school and will **not** be allowed to get breakfast after they have gone to the classroom. We will depend on teachers to enforce this rule...no exceptions will be made!!

Kindergarten Lunches:

Orders **must come** to the chef by 9:15am. If a child comes late to class, after you have already placed the lunch order, please call Tr. Neyza at ext. 2228. She will coordinate getting lunch for that child.
