**INDEPENDENCE CHARTER SCHOOL (ICS)  
2010-2011 Student Lottery Information Sheet**

Thank you for expressing an interest in Independence Charter (ICS). **Read both sides of this information sheet carefully** to understand the process utilized by ICS. If you are not familiar with both the Spanish Enhanced and Spanish Immersion programs that ICS offers, be sure to get clarification BEFORE submitting the application.

Only one application can be submitted per student. Be sure to submit your completed application by the lottery deadline; however, **since changes cannot be made to the application after it is submitted** (i.e., asking to switch from one the Immersion lottery to the Enhanced lottery), **be sure you have noted the correct program (Spanish Enhanced or Spanish Immersion) on the application.** Except for Kindergarten, which has only one waiting list no matter which program preference a family has chosen, ICS develops separate waiting lists each year through the lottery process for each grade and program (Spanish Enhanced and Spanish Immersion). ICS does not carry waiting lists over from year-to-year. So, if a child is on the waiting list for the 2010-2011 school year and a space does not become available, the child's name does **not** automatically go on to a waiting list for 2011-2012; the family must submit a new application for the 2011-2012 lottery.

To be part of the lottery process, completed application packets must be returned to the school in person no later than 5pm (Eastern Standard Time) on **Friday, November 20, 2009** as noted on the application. Applications not eligible for the lottery process (those received after the lottery deadline or those for students living outside of Philadelphia) will be accepted for the waiting list through the last day of the current school year and will be added to the end of the waiting list for the particular grade in the order they are received (2010-2011 applications will be accepted through June 19, 2010).

Sibling preference will only be given for siblings living in the same household (either all the time or through joint custody) as the current ICS (in grades K-8<sup>th</sup>) sibling AND when submitted before the lottery deadline. Any sibling preference applications received after the lottery deadline will be added to the end of the sibling waiting list. If a child is accepted for the upcoming school year through sibling preference, but the sibling (who had been at ICS) does not return for the following school year (or in the case of siblings of an 8<sup>th</sup> grader if the 8<sup>th</sup> grade sibling left before graduating), sibling preference is no longer valid.

**Applications can be submitted in person during scheduled school days between the hours 10a.m.-3p.m.** Families can call to schedule an appointment outside of those hours.

At the time of application submission, in addition to bringing in the completed application, copies of the following documents are required:

- proof of Pennsylvania residence (a utility bill, lease or mortgage statement with the name of at least one parent and the current address). If you do not have proof of Pennsylvania residence, contact ICS before coming in to submit your application to find out what other documentation would be acceptable.**
- the child's birth certificate or passport.**
- parent photo identification (i.e., driver's license, state identification card, etc).**
- to submit an application for a child who lives with you, but for whom you are not the parent, original court documents must be brought in for review. Contact ICS if you have further questions regarding these types of situations.**

**FOR KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS ONLY:** in addition to the copies of required documents, the ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS must also be brought in for review.

No faxed, mailed or incomplete applications will be accepted. At the time of dropping off the application, the parent/guardian will also be asked to complete a postcard that will later be mailed regarding the child's status. Parents are reminded to contact ICS with any address and/or phone changes. **After the waiting list postcard is sent, parents will not receive further updates** regarding their child's place on the waiting list, **unless ICS comes to the child's name to offer a space.** Parents are welcome to **call ICS to ask about any movement on the waiting lists after July 1, 2010.**

### **Multiple children from a household in the same grade**

If a family has more than one child going into the same grade (i.e., twins, a foster child and a biological child, one child who was retained and is now in the same grade as a sibling, etc), an application needs to be completed for each child and each child's name will be entered individually into the lottery. If one of the children's names is chosen from the lottery **for a space in the kindergarten class**, the other child/ren from that family who are also going into kindergarten will be accepted. For grades 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, and for all cases where a kindergartner is not chosen from the lottery for a space in an in-coming kindergarten class, if a family has more than one child going into the same grade (i.e., twins, etc), an application will be completed for each child and each child's name will be entered individually for the lottery to be given a space on the waiting list. If/when ICS gets to one of that family's children on the Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup> waiting lists, the other sibling(s) will be moved to a sibling waiting list; however, there is no guarantee that a space will become available for those siblings.

### **Lottery**

The lottery takes place in the evening on the first Friday in December of each year (subject to change in case of inclement weather, etc) and is open to the public. The information card for each child for whom an application was received by the lottery deadline will be put in a box according to the grade and program (i.e., boxes will be marked "K Enhanced," "K Immersion," etc.). The ICS charter gives preference to Philadelphia residents; therefore, any application received by the lottery deadline for a Pennsylvania applicant who does not reside in Philadelphia will **not** be included in the lottery process. The names of those applicants will be added to the end of the waiting for their particular grades after the lottery process takes place.

Notification for incoming kindergartners chosen for spaces in the in-coming kindergarten classes from the lottery will be mailed out by mid-December, with registration occurring in the late winter. Please note that **ALL 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade applicants go onto waiting lists.** Postcards, noting the child's place on the waiting lists for kindergartners not chosen for a space in a kindergarten class and for grades 1-8, are mailed out by the end of December.

### **Contacting Waiting List Children**

If/when ICS comes to a child's name on the waiting list, ICS will contact the next person from the waiting list (first going to the sibling list, then to the general waiting list) via telephone and (if available) e-mail (it is the families' responsibility to keep ICS informed of updated contact information). If a child is accepted from the waiting list for a space at ICS and that child has another sibling on an ICS waiting list (who meets the ICS sibling preference policy), that sibling will be moved to the sibling waiting list. If the family that is called does not respond to ICS within the given timeframe, a letter is sent notifying that family that ICS is assuming they are not interested and the next name is called. Students called from any of the ICS Spanish Immersion waiting lists for grades 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will be tested to determine if the child has the Spanish skills necessary for him or her to be successful in the Spanish Immersion program. If the child is not able to perform at an acceptable level, s/he will not be able to enroll at ICS. When ICS contacts a family from the waiting list and is informed that the child is either being retained in his/her current grade or being promoted two grades (instead of one), the child will be moved to the top of the non-sibling waiting list for the "new" grade, but there will not be a guarantee that ICS will be able to offer the child a space in that grade.

- Please complete each item, sign, and date this application.
- A separate application must be submitted for each child applying.
- Return the completed application to the school (you must come to the school in person; mailed and faxed applications will not be accepted) Monday through Friday between 10a.m. and 3:00p.m. (call for an appointment if other arrangements need to be made).
- At the time of application submission, you must also **bring copies** of your child's birth certificate or passport, proof of residence (current utility bill, mortgage or lease papers, etc which includes at least one of the parent's names and the current address) and parent/guardian photo identification. For **KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS ONLY**, the original documents must also be brought in for ICS staff review.
- To be qualified to enter the kindergarten lottery, your child must turn 5 years old by 9/1/2010; there are no exceptions made.
- Applications for the lottery will be accepted through November 20, 2009 at 5p.m. Eastern Standard Time
- Missing information will result in the return of this application or disqualification.
- The ICS lottery will take place on Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup> at 5p.m. at the school.

Please note that ICS provides sibling preference, accepting eligible in-coming kindergarten siblings of current ICS students without a lottery and adding 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade siblings to a sibling waiting list, only if a completed application is provided by the lottery deadline. Siblings for whom applications are received after the lottery deadline will be placed at the end of the waiting list.

Independence Charter School of Philadelphia, PA is a state authorized K-8 public charter school which opened its doors in September, 2001 with Kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. The ICS charter was renewed by the Philadelphia School District in 2005; we anticipate our second renewal in 2010.

Independence Charter School is committed to teaching Spanish to all students and offers two different programs: Spanish Enhanced and Spanish Immersion. The Spanish Enhanced program is conducted primarily in English with Spanish instruction occurring a minimum of 30 minutes a day, 4 to 5 times per week. In the Spanish Immersion program, a large portion of the child's school day is conducted totally in Spanish. The goal of Immersion classes is to have students emerge bilingual and biliterate in Spanish and English. If ICS gets to a child's name on a Spanish Immersion waiting list, the family will be contacted to schedule a testing appointment to determine if the child would be able to be successful in the Spanish Immersion program (based on the child's ability to read, write and speak in Spanish at that time).
